



Where can Ozone and Particulate Matter be found?

High amounts of ozone and PM can be found in and around urbanized and industrialized areas. This is because these areas produce a large amount of pollutants and emissions from cars and power plants.

Ozone and PM can also be found in rural areas. Agriculture, burning wood, and operating landscaping machinery are just a few examples of activities that can contribute to higher amounts of PM in rural areas. Weather patterns and systems can also move these pollutants from urbanized areas into rural areas.
